49.5% were symptomatic

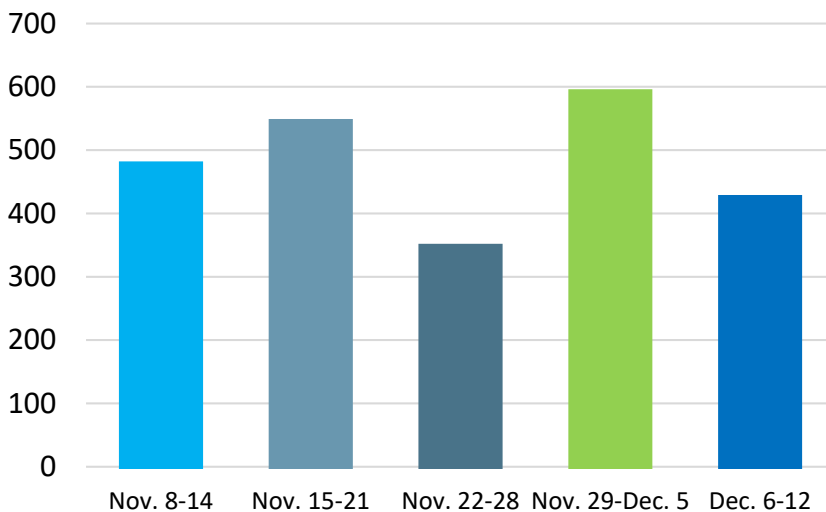
4.8% were asymptomatic

45.7% did not report symptom status

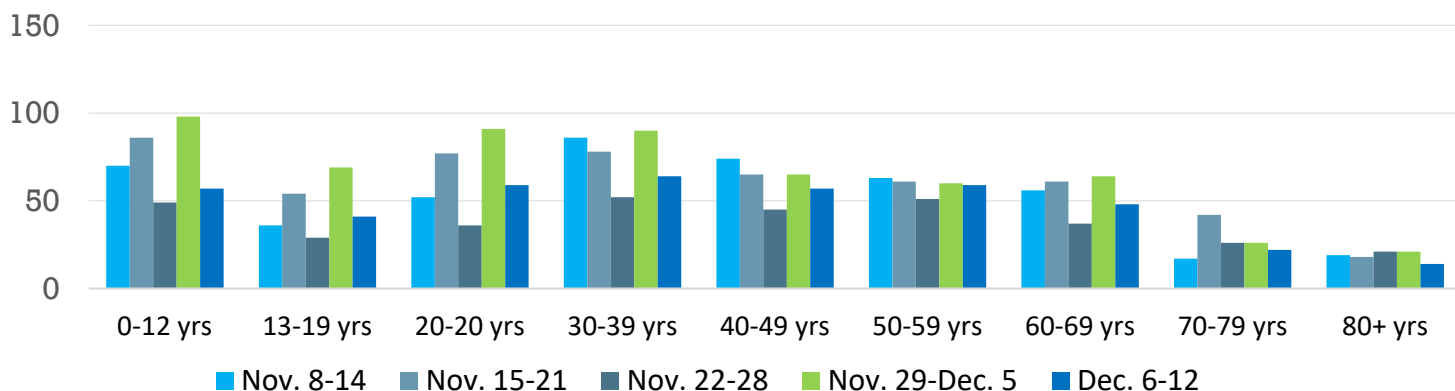
Hospitalizations: **57 cases**

Fully vaccinated individuals meet the following criteria:

- (1) 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines,
OR
- (2) 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine.

Not vaccinated/unvaccinated includes those that do not meet the criteria of a fully vaccinated individual (outlined above).

Breakthrough cases are formally defined as the detection of SARS-CoV-2 RNA or antigen in a respiratory specimen collected from a person who is ≥ 14 days after completion all recommended doses of a U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA)-authorized COVID-19 vaccine.
