

**REQUEST FOR WORK – ST. JAMES CAMPGROUND ACCESS ROAD – ST JAMES TOWNSHIP**

St James Township is seeking a price quote for work on the St. James Campground main access road to be completed at the St James Township Campground property. Any licensed excavator or contractor wishing to submit a quote on this project must recognize that this is to be completed by April 1, 2020.

The following work should be completed:

1. Remove all marked trees and or branches as necessary. Trees less than 6” diameter, brush and all tops to be removed from site.
2. Trees of 6” diameter or greater shall be cut to 10’ lengths and moved to location agreed upon between contractor and township personnel and stacked into a decking pile to be used for camper firewood.
3. Remove all stumps and level ground where necessary.
4. Groom area along roadway in preparation for spring grading and gravel addition.

Interested bidders must attend an onsite meeting on Wednesday, January 22, 2020 @12:30PM. Meet at the entrance to the campground.
